REQUIRED DANCE CLASS DRESS CODES

Class dress codes are required to ensure dancers can move properly, instructors can see lines for corrections, and there are no distractions in class. Dress codes will be strictly enforced at all levels.

If a dancer repeatedly breaks dress code they will be removed from their class.

TAP/BALLET/GYM (3-6YRS)



Required Attire:

Any color ballet shoes



Tap Shoes



Any color leotard, tights are mandatory

Hair must be secured out of face in ponytail, braid, or bun

Attached skirts are okay, but not recommended as they can be distracting during gymnastics.

all dance shoes must be in a dance bag that students will bring into class with them. No additional toys or belongings such as car keys should be in dance bags

JAZZ/HIP-HOP (3-4YRS)



Required Attire:

Any color jazz shoes



Any color leotard, tank top, spandex shorts, yoga pants (form fitted clothing) that dancers can move in



Hair must be secured out of face in ponytail, braid, or bun

TWIRLING TOTS (2-4YRS)

Required Attire:

Any color ballet shoes



Any color leotard, tights are mandatory



Hair must be secured out of face in ponytail, braid, or bun

CHEER/POM



Required Attire:

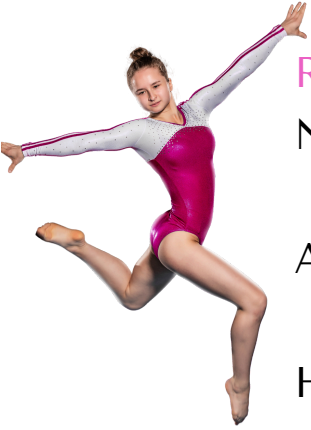
White sneakers

Any color leotard, tank top, spandex shorts, yoga pants (form fitted clothing) that dancers can move in



Hair must be secured out of face in ponytail, braid, or bun

ACRO/GYMNASTICS



Required Attire:

No shoes

Any color leotard/unitard

Hair must be secured out of face in a bun

BALLET



Required Attire:

Pink or skin tone ballet shoes



Plain Leotard (see specific levels for assigned color)

Ballet skirts are approved for only dancers 10+

Fairytale Ballet: White

Ballet 1 : White

Ballet 2: Lavender/Light Purple

Ballet 3: Navy Blue

Ballet4: Plum/Dark Purple

Ballet 5: Black

*Saturdays (Free Day): Dancers may wear any color leotard of their choice



Pink or skin tone tights

Hair must be in a secure bun

Males: Black shorts, dance pants or tights & plain white t-shirt/ tank

& black ballet shoes

NO sweatpants **Level 3 and up must wear black male tights

JAZZ/LYRICAL/CONTEMPORARY/SHOW TEAM



Required Attire:

Any color jazz shoes or half soles



Any color leotard, tank top, spandex shorts, yoga pants (form fitted clothing) that dancers can move in

Hair must be secured out of face in ponytail, braid, or bun

HIP-HOP/TAP/ BROADWAY BOUND



Required Attire:

Any comfortable clothing (no jeans) that dancers can move in comfortably

top must be fitted, bottoms must be loose fitting for hip hop

Hair must be secured out of face in ponytail, braid, or bun



shoes for hip hop: flat CLEAN sneakers such as converse or vans

shoes for broadway bound: jazz shoes or jazz sneakers



shoes for tap: any color tap shoes

TUITION RATES

DANCE STUDIOS

On Pointe Dance Studio uses an automatic payment system that is charged on the 1st of every month. Upon signing up, a card is required to be put on file that will be charged the automatic monthly payments. If you would like to pay with a different card for the next month, please contact or see the front desk before the 1st of the month. To withdraw from a class, student/ guardian (if student is under the age of 18) must notify On Pointe of cancellation in writing via email or by filling out a class drop form at the front desk by the 20th of the month prior. No refunds will be given if classes are cancelled on or after the 1st of the month, unless in case of an illness (doctor's note must be provided). A \$10 late fee will be applied to tuition rates unpaid on the 8th of the month, a \$50 late fee will be applied to tuition rates unpaid on the 15th of the month. Students will be removed from classes on the 15th of the month, until tuition is paid.

WHAT TO EXPECT

When you arrive at the studio, please check in at the front desk

The "sign in sheet" will be near the front desk, please sign your dancer in each time they attend class

Dancers may bring water and a dance bag that they will take into class with their dance shoes

(Combo classes will start with tap and change into ballet shoes in class, with their teacher)

Dancers should use the restroom before class starts so they do not interrupt their class

Parents are welcome to watch class through the lobby window. We do not allow parent/guests inside the classroom during class to not to distract students.

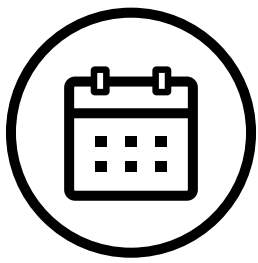
If your child has a hard time separating from you, please arrive early and talk to their teacher.

Classroom etiquette:

Dancers are expected to be in class, in proper attire, on time. If they have a cell phone, it must be turned off and not ring in class.

Dancers more than 10 minutes late will receive one warning, after that dancers will not be permitted to attend class. It is unsafe and disruptive for dancers to join a class late. Dancers in a combo class who are more than 10 mins late must wait until shoe change to join class

We expect dancers to be ready to work hard, be attentive, and respectful in class. Dancers should respect themselves, their teachers, and classmates. In return, instructors are expected to respect themselves and students we well. Our number one goal at On Pointe is to keep dancers safe and provide a positive atmosphere where they can grow and thrive.

What can I do if my child misses a class?

If your child misses a class they are able to take a make up class within 30 days (must be reserved in advance).

Will I be able to watch my child in class?

Yes, all of our dance rooms have windows that you can view from the lobby.

Where can I stay up to date with upcoming events?

You can stay up to date with any upcoming events by checking our social media, viewing our website, and checking the daily emails that are sent out.

Are you a vendor with any charter schools?

Yes, On Pointe Dance is a vendor with the following schools Cabrillo Academy, Elite Academic Academy, Epic, Granite Mountain, Julian Charter School, Mission Vista, Sage Oak, Compass, Excel Academy, Scale Leadership Academy, Springs, Sky Mountain, Suncoast Prep and Taylton

When is tuition due?

Tuition is due on the 1st of the month. If tuition is not paid by the 7th, students will not be able to take class. A \$10 late fee will be added to all payments made after the 7th of each month, a \$50 late fee will be added to all payments made after the 14th of each month. Students will be removed from class on the 15th of the month until tuition is paid. \$1 per minute will be charged for dancers who are not picked up from class within 10 mins of class ending. One exception per semester.

Am I able to drop or switch class for my child?

Yes, class changes can be done anytime as long as there is space in the class.

Class drops must be done by the 20th of the month prior. Class drops and changes must be submitted in writing, either in studio or email.



Tuition

1. On Pointe Dance Studio uses an automatic/ recurring payment system for monthly tuition. You may use a debit/credit card with a Visa, Mastercard and/or Discover logo that will be charged on the 1st of each month for that month's tuition.

2. All tuition is due on the 1st of each month. If tuition is not paid by the 7th, students will not be able to take class. A \$10 late fee will be added to all payments made after the 7th of each month, a \$50 late fee will be added to all payments made after the 14th of the month. Students will not be able to take class until tuition is paid. Student space in class will be forfeited after the 3rd week missed, if tuition is past due. \$1 per minute will be charged for dancers who are not picked up from class within 10 mins of class ending. One exception per semester.

Make-up Classes

1. Tuition is charged per month, not class attended. If you, or your child, miss a scheduled class, a make-up class can be taken within a month of the missed class (must reserve space in class) No refunds will be given for classes missed. (MAKE-UP CLASSES ARE FOR CURRENT STUDENTS ONLY. If a student is not enrolled at On Pointe Dance Studio, they cannot make-up classes).

Class Changes/Class Withdraws

1. To withdraw from a class, student/ guardian (if student is under the age of 18) must notify On Pointe of cancellation in writing via email or by filling out a class drop form at the front desk by the 20th of the month prior. No refunds will be given if classes are cancelled on or after the 1st of the month, unless in case of an illness (doctor's note must be provided)

2. If you want to change your child's class, you can do so at any time. Please see fill out a class change/drop form online. Please note that class spaces are limited.



Dancer Rules & Expectations

1. Students are required to be in class on time, with proper attire and hair pulled back. If a student is more than 15 minutes late to a class, they will be asked to sit out. This is for their own safety as the first 15-20 minutes of each class are spent stretching.
2. Students and/or parents that are disrespectful to other students, instructors and/or other On Pointe staff may be asked to leave studio. On Pointe reserves the right to refuse service.
3. Students taking "unlimited" classes, that miss 3 classes in a row, will forfeit their space in that class.

Health & Safety

1. It is the student/parent or guardian's responsibility to notify On Pointe Dance Studio of any medical conditions and/or student injuries. On Pointe Dance Studio is not responsible for student medical conditions or injuries. If a parent/guardian is not present and a child has a medical emergency, I consent to have On Pointe CPR/first aid certified staff assist my child.
2. Dancers will be enrolled in classes based on our physical activity guidelines for their age and level
3. I understand that I am personally responsible for my, and my child's, safety and actions while at On Pointe Dance Studio. I agree to comply with all On Pointe Dance Studio policies and rules. Because On Pointe Dance Studio is open for use by other individuals, I recognize that I am at higher risk of contracting COVID-19.

Miscellaneous

1. On Pointe students may be included in group/individual photos for any of On Pointe's websites and/or videos including recital photos/videos.
2. On Pointe Dance Studio is not responsible for lost/ stolen belongings. Please make sure your child has all belongings when entering and exiting class.
